General Responsibility

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Carry valid fork truck operators license, be willing to obtain/renew fork truck operators license
- Identify and deliver or route materials to presses using work devices such as hand truck or fork truck
- Identify material
- Perform visual quality checks of parts at the press notifying the Quality Assurance Manager of any discrepancy
- Assemble parts at all assembly stations
- Box, weigh and label parts for shipping or inventory
- Empty bins, sort and trim parts when necessary
- Grind runners and parts for future reuse
- Perform other assigned duties as requested by management
